Safety BINGO



Objective:

Students will learn safety rules about natural gas for inside and outside a building or home.

Materials and Curriculum Correlations

► Introduction

There are many safety considerations when using fuel sources at home, school or outside. Natural gas is used as a fuel for furnaces to heat homes, stoves or ranges to cook food, water heaters to heat water, gas grills for outdoor cooking, fireplaces and many other appliances. It is efficient, reliable and has fewer emissions than other fossil fuels. A pipeline delivers this fuel. Pipelines can be various sizes in diameter and made of different materials. A leak in a pipe, connector or fixture can be hazardous.

Review with your students the safety tips about natural gas inside and outside a home, school or business. Discuss with students the importance of knowing and following the safety rules and tips below.

Inside

- 1. Teach children how to use appliances safely and to recognize the smell, mercaptan, added to natural gas.
- 2. Keep flammable materials (paint, solvents, cloth, paper) away from appliances.
- 3. Provide proper ventilation in areas around furnaces, water heaters, dryers, ranges, etc.
- 4. Make sure all vents and chimneys are free from blockage.
- 5. If you smell the natural gas odor mercaptan in the house:
 - a. Tell an adult and leave the area at once.
 - b. Do not use the phone, light switches or flashlights.
 - c. Leave the doors open.
 - d. Call 911 and the natural gas company from a neighbor's house.
 - e. Stay away until the natural gas company says it is safe to return.
- 6. When lighting a natural gas appliance, always ignite the flame first, then turn on the natural gas.
- 7. Keep fire extinguishers in the vicinity of appliances with open flames.
- 8. Follow manufacturer's instructions for the installation, operation and maintenance of gas equipment and appliances.
- 9. Have routine maintenance performed on appliances to keep them clean and in proper working order.
- 10. Clean or change filters on furnaces and dryers regularly.
- 11. Check the temperature setting on the water heater. It should be set at 120 F.
- 12. Install a carbon monoxide (CO) detector in your home.

Outside

- 1. Don't play near any natural gas equipment, including pipes and the meter.
- 2. Call 811 before digging in the yard to locate underground pipelines.
- 3. Never pull out or move marker flags that mark the location of underground pipelines.
- 4. Never use natural gas appliances intended for outdoor use indoors or in a garage.

Procedure

- After discussing the natural gas safety rules and tips, play Safety BINGO by giving each student a Safety BINGO card.
 - a. Using a pencil or crayon have students put a mark like an X over the word that answers the questions or completes the sentence.
 - b. If you want to reuse the cards, use marker pieces to cover the word(s).
- 2. Read the following phrases and have students find the word or phrase that matches the answer on their card. Continue until a student has a BINGO, a complete line vertical, horizontal or diagonal.
 - a. To play with three in a row, read three to four sentences or questions.
